What is a Group Project?
A group project contains multiple buildings or spaces that may be certified as a group within one LEED project registration, where the entire group, with a single LEED project boundary, receives a single rating and certification.

What if I'm registering on behalf of someone else in my company?
The person's name and email that you enter during registration will become the primary point of contact for member correspondence from USGBC.

Start your project off right.

The three-step process makes registering your project quick and easy.

Fill in your project information, sign the certification agreement, and pay the registration fee. No hassle.

Keep track, credit by credit.

Your project scorecard is the best way to stay on top of credits attempted,

under review, and earned.

You'll also see forms, comments and actual credit language for each credit along with its up-to-the-minute review status.
